Volunteers Needed for Visit of *The Wall That Heals*

Replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial to be in Edison Oct. 14 – 17

New Brunswick, NJ, July 8, 2004 – According to Ken Holman, volunteer coordinator for the Middlesex County Veterans' Advisory Council, volunteers of all ages are needed to help out when *The Wall That Heals*, a half-scale replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, DC, is on display Oct. 14 – 17 at Roosevelt Park, Edison.

“We’re looking for people to help in the information booth, with parking, visitor assistance, computers and a variety of other things,” said Holman. This traveling exhibit features a 250-foot replica of The Wall, as well as an Information Center and museum displaying memorabilia left at The Wall in Washington, DC. The visit is being sponsored by the Middlesex County Veterans' Advisory Council, The Board of Chosen Freeholders, and the Middlesex County Cultural and Heritage Commission.
