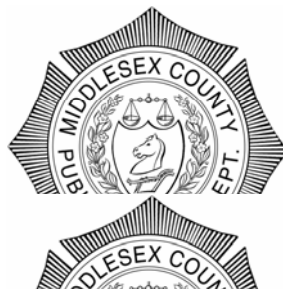

Program Description: The Women's Trauma and Addiction Program is a comprehensive, innovative, cutting edge model of treatment for women who are experiencing the emotional effects of trauma while simultaneously trying to get into or are in recovery from an addiction. The relationship between trauma and addiction is intense and complex. They exacerbate each other, creating a vicious cycle that binds women into chronic relapsing. Instead of viewing relapse as a failure, this program uses the relapses in a specialized way to enhance motivation for recovery. Care is based on individual needs. Both the trauma and the addiction work can be done as an inpatient for short-term crisis stabilization or detox, or as an outpatient participant in a six-hour a-day partial hospital program. Intensive inpatient or outpatient services are available for individual, group or family therapy.
